Kristine Huskey

Nationally recognized human rights attorney

About the speaker:

Kristine Huskey is currently a Practitioner-in-Residence in the International Human Rights Law Clinic at American University Washington College of Law. Prior to that, she was an attorney in the international litigation group at Shearman & Sterling LLP for eight years.

While at Shearman & Sterling, Ms. Huskey was selected to be part of the legal team representing detainees at Guantanamo Bay, Cuba being held by the U.S. government as suspected terrorists. As a key member of that team, Ms. Huskey interviewed detainees, traveled to Kuwait to interview their family members and ultimately represented the Guantanamo detainees in Rasul v. Bush, which went before the Supreme Court and won the right of the detainees to challenge their detentions in federal court.

Ms. Huskey has been to Guantanamo over a dozen times and has frequently appeared in the media to discuss Guantanamo. She will be discussing her experiences as a women attorney in the representation of the Guantanamo detainees and in particular how she was able to build relationships with her clients and effectively represent them before the courts.
